



Tax deduction card 2012 withholding tax on pensions – information about income

If you request that your tax be calculated pursuant to the rules that apply to people who are resident in Norway, you must provide information about your pay, pension and income from business activities in Norway and abroad. If you are married, you must also include your spouse's income.

If you are claiming a deduction for interest on debt, you must provide information about capital in the form of real property abroad and about all your income in Norway and abroad.

If you are claiming a tax reduction because of low general income, you must provide information about all your income, deductions, assets and debt. If you are married, you must also include your spouse's income, deductions, assets and debt.
