Who should submit this form?

If you move to Norway for a period of 6 months or more, or if your move is permanent, you must send a notification of your move to a tax office in Norway, see the National Registration Act sections 4-2, subsection 1 and 6-2. You report your move by completing and submitting this form. If you have a residence permit from the immigration authorities, the National Population Register will consider whether you should be registered as settled in Norway based on the information we receive from the immigration authorities. This does not apply if you have a right of residence pursuant to EEA regulations. Contact the tax office for more information.

How to submit the form

Everybody who is entered in this form must report their move by visiting a tax office that performs ID controls. You must book an appointment in advance. You can find the address to the closest ID office, get more information about what you must bring and book an appointment at skatteetaten.no/movetoNorway. You may be asked to provide documentation to prove that you'll be living in Norway, for example an employment contract or proof of residential property. If you have any questions, you can contact us at skatteetaten.no/contact.

A Who has moved?

In this form, you can report a move for yourself and/or other people in your household. For people under 18 years of age, the person or persons with parental responsibility are obliged to report the move and sign the notification.

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If you're reporting a move to Norway, you must sign the notification. You can sign on behalf of a spouse, a cohabiting partner, a partner or children aged under 18 for which you have parental responsibility if you're also entered in this notification. All who sign must be aged over 18. If the notification of the move only relates to children aged under 18, it must be signed by those with parental responsibility or a guardian/supporting guardian.

If you have joint parental responsibility and your child moves from another Nordic country, the other parent must also sign. If the move is from a non-Nordic country, it's sufficient that the form is signed by the parent moving with the child. If you have the sole parental responsibility and your child moves from another Nordic country, you must provide evidence of this with a printout from the population register in the country you moved from, or a printout proving that the parents do not reside on the same address. The printout must be original, stamped and signed, and no more than three months old.
