*For those under 18 years of age, the obligation to submit and sign the notification lies with the person or persons with parental responsibility, and who the child is registered as living with.

What is a property unit number? (Formerly called dwelling number.)

If the postal address you report is an address in Norway, and the address is a residential address, you must always state the property unit number for the address. All residential addresses in Norway have a property unit number (formerly called dwelling number), and all apartments should have an address label with the property unit number attached to the door frame.

The address label should be visible on or by the door. The property unit number consists of one letter and four digits, and it is stated on the address label that is stuck on or next to the door.

IF YOU DO NOT KNOW THE PROPERTY UNIT NUMBER FOR YOUR ADDRESS, you can read more about how to find it at skatteetaten.no/unitnumber/. If you rent an apartment, you can contact the person you are renting from, or you can contact the municipality where you live.
